Granny Square Challenge

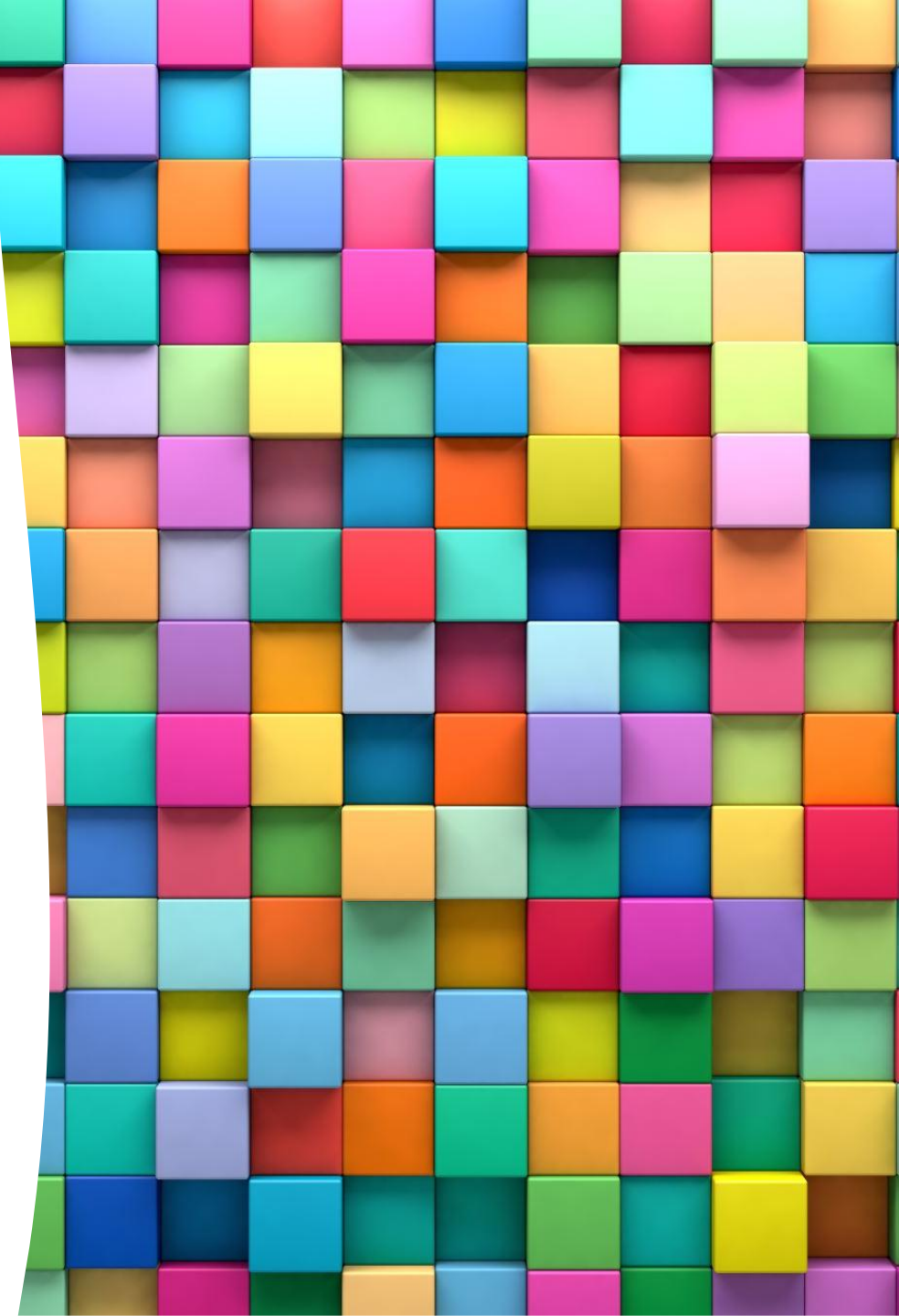
